Some things we have been doing:

The walk in cooler was completely renovated.  
The bathrooms on the south wing were completed  
New metal roofing was installed on the last two camper cabins.  
Dock was repaired before putting in the lake.  
The mowing and weed whacking of grounds done as needed.  
Facility water treated with chlorine and tested daily as required by Sask. Health.  
Dishwasher tested daily for sanitation required by Sask. Health.  
Tree trimming and removal of dead trees.  
Cleaning grounds of garbage and tree branches.  
Gophers and Mice are under control.  
A fifth bathroom with a shower and a wheelchair bathroom with a shower is being installed.

Some things we need to do:

New exit doors on the wings of the main building.  
Siding on the two new camper cabins.  
Service the boiler.  
Clean roots out of the well.  
Clean the 1,000 gallon holding tank at the well.  
Some grading needs to be done around main building.
