

Terms of Registration for Strasbourg Bible Camp, a Ministry of Deeper Life:

1. I hereby give consent for my child's participation at SBC and all related activities. I understand that the programming includes physical activity in the form of a variety of sports and recreational activities. I agree that SBC will not be held liable for any injury to my child, or loss or damage to my child's personal property. In consideration of my child being allowed to participate in the camp, I, the parent/guardian of the child, on my own behalf and on behalf of my child, waive all present and future claims against SBC and its directors, volunteers, employees, officers, servants, representatives, insurers and agents (and their respective successors and assigns - collectively, the "Releasees") and hereby release the Releasees from and against all liabilities, claims, actions, demands, costs and expenses relating to injury, illness, death, loss, damage to person or property or loss of property, foreseen or unforeseen, howsoever caused, arising out of or in connection with my child's participation at SBC.
2. I hereby give permission for my child to be photographed and/or recorded during Strasbourg Bible Camp (herein called SBC) programs or events. I understand that the photos and/or recordings and my child's name will be used to keep a journal of activities, to share during presentations and for promotional purposes. I understand that although the photographs and/or recordings may be used for advertising, the identity of my child will not be disclosed without permission. I do not expect compensation and agree that all photos and/or recordings are the property of SBC.
3. I hereby give permission for the transportation of my child for official SBC activities by modes of transportation agreed to by the camp organizers and only by those authorized to do so.
4. In case of emergency, I understand every effort will be made to contact me. In the event that I cannot be reached in an emergency situation, I hereby give permission to licensed emergency and health care personnel to provide treatment, services and transport necessary to maintain the health of my child. In the event medication, medical advice, treatment and/or equipment are required, I agree to accept financial responsibility for fees in excess of provincial and or private medical insurance. I agree that the information on my child's application may be disclosed to such emergency and health care personnel. In the event of illness, accident, emergency, or any other circumstance requiring medical treatment, such treatment may be procured for the participant without legal or financial obligation to SBC. All known health issues of my child have been stated to SBC. I will notify SBC if my child is exposed to any infectious diseases prior to arriving at camp.
5. I understand that there is a risk of exposure to any virus or illness while we attend the facility and/or programming, in spite of the precautions that have been taken by SBC in following directions outlined by local health authorities to try to limit exposure. I further understand if I have a pre-existing condition, it may make them more vulnerable to a virus or illness.
6. I understand that my child will be placed in a cabin dependant on their birth sex with cabin leaders of the same sex. If this is an area of concern, I understand that I can contact the leadership for discussion.
7. Furthermore, I agree that I and my child attending will obey all SBC rules and take full responsibility for behavior in addition to any damages caused to the facilities utilized by SBC.

I have read and understood the terms of this agreement and by registering my child to participate in camp at SBC, I am voluntarily agreeing to abide to these terms. I confirm that the participant [my child] is physically and mentally able to participate in all activities of the camp, unless specifically indicated otherwise in writing.
